RESURECTIONAL HYMN (TONE 4)

Having learned the joyful message of the Resurrection from the angel the women disciples of the Lord cast from them their parental condemnation. And proudly broke the news to the Disciples, saying: Death hath been spoiled; Christ God is risen, granting the world Great Mercy.

HYMN-FOR THE NATIVITY OF THE THEOTOKOS (TONE 4)

circumcised, that they may
boast in your flesh. But God

Jesus Christ, through Whom
the world is crucified to me,
and I to the world. For in Christ
Jesus, neither circumcision
counts for anything, nor
uncircumcision, but a new
creation. And as many as
walk according to this rule,
peace be upon them, and
mercy, and upon the Israel of
God. Henceforth, let no one
trouble me; for I bear in my
body the brand-marks of the
Lord Jesus. The grace of our
Lord Jesus Christ be with your
spirit, brethren. Amen.
